This scarf is made wit normal k itting and fingerknitting! Enjoy and have fun.

You can also make the fingerknitting with different kind of yarns.



Finished measurements: as long as

you want - One size! ;-))

**Yarn:** scarf: SMART superwash [100% wool; 100 m per 50g / 1 OZ 76]; colours: red and pink, 150 g / 5,2911 oz

or more

Fingerknittingribbons: Phildar Anouchka [80% acrylic, 16 % mohair, 4 % wool;

40 g/1 oz 2/5]

**Gauge** is not important in this project.

**Materials needed** 

yarn needle scissors

Needle size: needles US 8 / 5 mm and

your fingers (to finger knitting)

### **Pattern Notes**

Tip to start all rows: hold the yarn on left finger (away from you). Insert right needle p-wise in first st (tip to tip), p, pull the yarn kindly, then p across.

Stitches - knit: CO (cast on), BO (bind off), k (knit), p (purl)

#### Scarf

CO35 sts

Rows 1 - 10: k

Row 11: k2, \*BO2, k4\*, rep \*-\* until last 3 sts: k

Row 12: k but CO2 where you've BO across

Rep rows 11- 33 until the scarf measures about 140 cm / 55 inches or as long as you want

# **Fingerknitting**

With yarn in a contrast colour make 5 laces with finger knitting. The laces must be longer than the scarf, choose yourself how long.

### **Finishing**

Weave the 5 laces into the holes and make a knot in each end of each laces/fringe.
Weave in ends.
