My Christmas Cards - 2007

This pattern belongs to_



As usual every year I create my Christmas cards on my own... my own idea, my own pattern.

In 2007 I used my hook and crocheedt some items! I also made some gift-tags.

Skill level: easy

You need: a hook that goes with your yarn

yarn/wool, cotton, acrylic, just have a look in your leftovers!

optional: buttons

board card in different colours

envelopes scissors glue felt tips to write your greetings

Tree

Cn10 with green yarn

Row 1 - in second cn from hook: 1sl st, 1sc in each of next 2 cns, 1hdc in next 2 cns, 1dc in each of next 2 cns, 1tc in each of next 2 cns, 1 double tc in last cn

now make sl sts in the double tc in order to bring the yarn to the cn.

Row 2: cn3 (or 4, must be as long as your double to on the opposite site!), then crochet opposite: 1tc in each of next 2 cns, 1hdc in next 2 cns, 1sc in each of



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next 2 cns, 1sl st, 1sl st in the first cn.

Cut yarn and fix.

Tip: maybe the double to are too "open", just weave in the thread up and down to close the "holes".

Star

Cn4 and close into a ring.

Rnd 1: *cn5, 1sc around the ring*, rep *-* four times more.

Cut yarn and weave in.

Tip: add small buttons as balls on the tree.



Angels

Body: like the tree but with white, pink, or light blue cotton thread.

Winas:

cn 12-15 and fix in the first cn of body with a sl st. Make the second wind the same.

As you can see in the picture the light blue angel has got white wings, and I made arms just adding a short chain.

Head: find some buttons you like. Glue on the card.

Star

Cn2

Rnd 1: 5sc in second cn from hook, close the rnd with 1sl in first sc

Rnd 2: *1sc in next sc, 2scs in next sc*, rep *-* around (1 sc)

Rnd 3: *2sc in next 2 scs, 2sc in next sc*, re+ *-* around



cn6, turn, 1sl st in second cn from hook, 1sc in next cn, 1sc in next cn, 1hc in next cn, 1 dc in next cn, lay along the centre and fix with 1sl st. Make 4 points more. Cut yarn and weave in the thread.

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
